Parent Contract

1. **Playing Time:** It is earned and at the discretion of the coach.

The coach determines the amount of time a player is on the court and it is based on the athlete's ability, potential, attitude, position, team's need at the moment and the team's need in the future. The coach will not be required to defend their thought process in determining any of these conclusions and it is improper for a parent to request it. However, coaches often enjoy discussing the tactics of volleyball, and that may shed light on particular decisions. Educating parents on the complexities of the game of volleyball often helps answer parent concerns and questions. These conversations are welcome, as long as they are approached in an open-minded manner, clearly designed to better understand the game as a whole. Rogue staff may decide to share their decisions with parents, but are not obligated to do so. Those decisions will be handled on a case-by-case basis, depending, in part, on the manner in which questions are raised.

We will not discuss any athlete other than the parent's own.

Remember grievances should always be handled between the parties involved and the decision makers in the situation, not other parents or players from the team. Repetitive complaining by athlete(s) or third parties that interfere with the Clubs efforts to pursue its grievance policy and purpose may be asked as by the Club Director to leave the Club.

2. **Attending matches:** All spectators are asked to avoid berating referees
3. **Attendance:** Attendance is required. Since match play is solely up to the discretion of the head coach, playing time will be affected by poor attendance. players will communicate well in advance concerning any missed practices or conflicts.
4. **Negativity and Poor Sportsmanship:** All staff, players, and spectators will avoid harsh criticism, extreme negativity, and displays of poor sportsmanship throughout the process. We will not tolerate hostile, aggressive confrontations to any of the coaching staff, or towards other athletes, and/or Parents. If this type of behavior does happen, the person and/or persons involved and the athlete will be sanctioned by the Club. Each situation will be handled on a case-by-case basis. All decisions will be made by the club only and will not be scrutinized or discussed by the other players and/or parents.

We cannot reach our goals without the full support of the parents. Understand that if you have negative opinions about something, those may not be shared by others. Swaying others to share your views may seem desirable at times, but rarely does it ever become productive. Most parents disagree with you, and you may end up being ostracized or viewed as generally unpleasant to be around. Keep this in mind.

5. **Respect for Facilities:** All staff, players, and spectators will clean up after themselves.
6. **Event Behavior:** No player will leave until entire team is dismissed after last match or officiating duty.

Refing schedules will be assigned. We will be the best refing team in the country, and will treat the refing process with respect. With the game getting faster and faster, line judges and R2s play a critical role in the outcome of matches. We need to ref the way we want others to ref our matches.

7. Travel Behavior: Players will avoid any conduct that is illegal or immoral; players and families will attend and support all team meetings and functions; players will heed curfew and appropriate public behavior. Any deviation from the above will necessitate parent contact and possible dismissal from the event.
8. Please note that in the case of a player being dismissed for any of the above violations, all money collected will be non-refundable.

DUES:

1. PAYMENT OF ALL DUES/FEEES ONLY PROVIDES THE PLAYER A “SPOT” ON A TEAM. NO REPRESENTATION OR WARRANTEE IS MADE BY THE CLUB CONCERNING PLAYING TIME, GUARANTEED POSITION, ETC.
2. Your dues cover expenses for practices, training development, facility, equipment, coaches’ compensation, tournament entry fees, USAV/AAU/JVA Volleyball fees, travel expenses, and administrative expenses. Though fees are billed over a span of several months per the schedule below, EXECUTION OF THIS DOCUMENT OBLIGATES THE PARENT FOR THE FULL AMOUNT OF THE CLUB FEE IRRESPECTIVE IF—FOR WHATEVER REASON—THE PLAYER DOES NOT COMPLETE THE SEASON WITH THE CLUB.
3. Club Fees are collected according to the payment plan chosen online when roster spots are accepted, unless arrangements are made in advance with the Director prior to signing this Agreement. Late payments need to be communicated with the Director no less than 14 days prior to payment due date. Late fees will be assessed a \$50 penalty.
4. Fees paid to the club are NON-REFUNDABLE. If a player is unable to complete the season due to an injury resulting from an official Rogue event, we will work with you on a refund plan.
5. FEE SCHEDULE: There are several options online. You agree to the schedule as chosen by you.

Should any Player/Parent not comply with the terms of this Financial Agreement, Rogue Volleyball reserves the right to pursue any member through legal proceedings and/or collection services for non-payment of dues or any associated fees owed to Rogue Volleyball. Such actions may result in adverse effects on the member’s credit scores and/or credit history. In addition, the expenses of the legal fees and collections agency incurred by Rogue will be included.

From USAV:

The Palmetto Region expects each volleyball Club to perform as an independent business, run and managed by its director and/or board. In order for a Club to maintain their membership with the Palmetto Region, the Club must follow the rules and guidelines set forth by the Palmetto Region and USVA.

When joining a Club, the player and parents are contracting with a specific Club for services, not with the Region. In choosing a club, it is important for the parents to question the Club’s Director on how each Club manages their business affairs. In the event a Club fails to meet its contractual obligations to its members, the Region has the right and authority to sanction or terminate a Club’s membership in the Palmetto Region.

If a parent has a concern regarding their Club not meeting its contractual obligations, they may contact the Palmetto Region Office.
